

Transparency Policy

First: Providing Information to Stakeholders

Al-Yusr Organization believes that transparency is the foundation for building trust with donors, regulatory bodies, and the public. The organization is committed to providing and facilitating access to vital information about its operations by regularly publishing the following materials on its official website:

A comprehensive annual report detailing operations, administrative systems, completed projects, success rates, and field expenditures.

Fully audited annual financial statements (balance sheet, income statement, and cash flow statement) accompanied by the external auditor's report.

The current organizational structure, names of board members and executive management, and the organization's official licenses.

Second: Disclosure of Funding Sources and Major Grants

The organization is committed to disclosing major funding sources (donor organizations, companies, major donors), the amount of funding received, and its expenditure in detail, taking into account local laws for the protection of personal data and the wishes of some individual donors not to disclose their names to the public, while making this data available in full and in detail to government regulatory bodies and relevant banks upon request.
